



**Boeing Eastern Regional
Headquarters**

As a result of consolidation with another aerospace giant, Boeing needed expansion of recently leased regional headquarters space. A rooftop executive center and a 200 seat flexible and secure conference center provided additional space and critical facilities.

The grade-level conference center design expresses a dynamic image for Boeing as an aerospace giant. The auditorium addition steps away from the existing building, minimizing obstruction to views and natural light at the second floor. The roof is sculpted into three curving light monitors, which provide additional height to the room, allow indirect north light into the space, and are reminiscent of the monitors found on early airplane hangers. The executive center provides excellent views of aircraft on the National Airport flight path. The executive level is a predominantly glass and metal pavilion, maximizing views and providing a light appearance for the rooftop structure. Dynamic wing-like roof forms express flight, blur the boundary between inside and out, accentuate soaring views, and complete the overall building composition by defining how the building meets the sky.
