

Accessory Structure

The Barn at Hazel River Cabin repurposes a hand hewk oak corn crib, which originally stood in Berks County, Pennsylvania, into a guest house and accessory structure on the grounds of Hazel River Cabin in Woodville, Virginia. Subtle red siding emphasizes the structure's historic use, while set-back barn doors, framed with black timber on the southeast corner provide contrasting modern lines and asymmetry. A patio offers an outdoor gathering space with views to the main house and to the nearby river and mountain. On the interior, exposed beams and rafters appeal to the barn's rustic aesthetic but are offset by colorful and contemporary furnishings.
